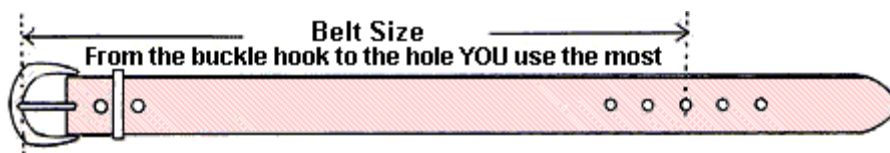

**Please follow the instructions below to insure a proper fitting belt.  
If using an old belt to measure, use this diagram:**



If you do not have an old belt, then order your belt 2 inches larger than the waist size of your pants, the result will be a belt that will fit you with 2 holes on either side of where you will wear it for flexibility.

If you wear extra large pants or *hip huggers* like today's styles, measure an old belt that fits or use a cloth tape measure and run it through your belt loops, pull it so it feels right, and that would be the size you order.

The belt size is NOT the total length of a belt, it is the center hole of the finished belt.

Note: The widths of our belts are 1/16th narrower than specified to allow for smooth operation with all buckles.

**DO NOT** order the size printed on the back of an old belt, these markings are generally the pant size and **NOT** the belt size.
